

Professor John Millican
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John Millican began his career as a navigating officer with the British and Commonwealth Shipping Company. The experience he gained, which included two round-the-world voyages and the rescue of the crew of a sinking bulk carrier, proved invaluable when he came ashore in 1982 to pursue an academic career, specialising in the education and training of ships' officers. As well as being professionally qualified, John holds a first class honours degree in law and an MSc in education management, and is a Chartered Marine Technologist.

John spent much of his career at the internationally-known Warsash Maritime Academy, including ten years as Director. During that time he also served on the Main Board of the Merchant Navy Training Board which oversees the professional education and training of UK seafarers. He recently retired as Dean of the Maritime and Technology Faculty, taking up a consultancy role as Emeritus Professor of Maritime Education.
